We are Solomon and Amanda Dixon and we are here by way of Buffalo, New York with our five children. Solomon Dixon

Writing, dancing, singing, playing the keys, Jujitsu, mountain climbing, breathwork, meditation, and Qigong. These are just some the arts of choices of Solomon Dixon. After working with not-for-profit groups, Citizens Campaign for the Environment and Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra in his early 20's, Solomon Dixon turned his efforts elsewhere. He found that teaching and performing were his primary passions. He began teaching writing, self-expression, and poetry around the United States and developed writing workshops for over 20 schools as well as working with over 30,000 students! He has shared his passion for writing with adolescents in a way that develops a writer at their very core. After growing up in foster care and being adopted as an adolescent, Solomon turned his trouble beginnings into a passion for mentorship and sharing life experiences to help each child become the best version of themselves.



Solomon has opened for Salt -N- Pepa, Public Enemy, Sharon Jones and the Dap-Kings, and other well know music groups and artist. He won So You Think You Can Dance New York Chapter and continues to use dance to open creative doors for children helping the to gain confidence and believe in themselves. After he co-founded The Living Poets Society, Solomon Dixon competed at the national level for individual and group competitions for spoken word poetry. He placed in the Top 50 Spoken Word artists in the world.

Solomon is a native to Syracuse, NY but in 2020, the Dixon family relocated to the Dominican Republic to open Forever Wild Children's Garden. He has been crucial to the ethos and community building between the children. Working daily on growth within ourselves through qi gong, meditation and breathwork, the kids are always excited to



see what challenges and activities Solomon will come up with each day!

Amanda Dixon

After teaching for nearly two decades in the United States, Amanda Dixon and her family moved to the Dominican Republic in 2020 to open their first international micro school, Forever Wild Children's Garden. In her early years,



she attended Canisius College in Buffalo, New York and earned her Bachelors' and Masters' Degree in Elementary Education. Throughout her 20's and 30's, Amanda Dixon has taught in charter schools and private schools in the cities of Buffalo, NY. Specializing in turning the most reluctant readers into reading super stars, Amanda focused all her efforts on raising the reading levels of young children at the elementary level at that time.

After years of work in the traditional school setting, she has turned her efforts elsewhere. She began to study different forest schools and styles of education. She has become fascinated by the idea that children can learn without explicit instruction while sitting in chairs, teachers lecturing and countless workbook pages. She has learned how children can explore, create and build outside in nature and become just as strong of readers, mathematicians and scientists. After having her own children, she began to design programming that would be built for them as they grew and attempted to implement into her own traditional classroom.

Teaching in schools hasn't been the only art keeping her busy. Gymnastics, dance, and drawing are the arts of choice for Amanda Dixon. After a decade in competitive gymnastics, Amanda turned to coaching and then taking dance classes at a local studio. Nowadays, she has turned all those arts into her classroom and instruction for children to explore.



With a background in traditional teaching from United States, Amanda Dixon brings that knowledge to build an exceptional homeschool enrichment program for children.

Our Forever Wild Drop Off Program

Forever Wild Members will have monthly access to our learning space where

we use our very own designed activities that focus on self discovery, building confidence and enriching their minds. These activities and offerings are customized for each group. You will see children of all ages doing handstands, obstacle courses, running and jumping and climbing on the same day as them meditating, singing and dancing. They will have opportunities to write and read and create. We always find ways to incorporate stick work and balance into our daily routine.



Alongside our daily hoemschooling enrichment, we work on building bonds, community, and confidence. We strengthen our voices to help us in all we do, and in turn, to help others. Enrichment examples we have covered are animal survival adaptations, geography, civilizations, governments and religions around the world, literature and creative writing. Enrichment varies month to month based on the children enrolled.

Drop Off Program Hours and Days

Our drop off program runs Monday through Thursday each week. Members can choose the morning session (9am-1pm) or the afternoon session (1pm-3pm) or both. The location where our drop off program is held will be sent out to those registered so that they can book accommodations accordingly.



<u>Fun Fridays</u>

The Forever Wild Drop Off Program runs Monday through Thursday, which leaves Fridays open. Those days we leave open for families to plan visits to temples, take cooking classes, take language lessons, visit theme parks, and more. All excursions would incur separate fees but families usually attempt to book together to receive the best group rates.

The Rhythm at Forever Wild

The morning session children arrive around 9am and can join in different free play activities. The children just joining us in the afternoon will arrive at 1pm. Below is an example of a schedule one day:

- 9:20am Arts and Theatre Games
- 10am Science Phenomena Fun & Explorations
- 11am Lunch Time and Meditation & Breathwork
- 12pm Story and Illustrations Club
- 1pm Stick Work and Obstacle Courses
- 2pm Creative Writing

Here is an example of another day:

- 9:20am Social Skills Games and What Would You Do?
- 10am Drawing and Making Explorations
- 11am Lunch Time and Sports
- 12pm Poetry and Public Speaking
- 1pm Stick Work and Qi Gong
- 2pm Fun with Numbers, Back to Basics

Some children will leave at 1pm, while others choose to stay for the afternoon sessions. The afternoon sessions end at 3pm.

The beauty in this type of homeschooling enrichment is that we block off an hour for each section, just to keep a rhythm. This type of loose schedule blocking leaves plenty of room between each activity to run and jump and climb and play. No matter how old they are, PLAY is so important for their bonding and social development. Join in our morning session, afternoon session or BOTH!

The rhythm is subject to change based on a special activity we might be offering one day, the weather, or the focus of the children. Let's just say we are not going to stop an amazing music session to move on if the children are thriving ©



Characteristics of Families that Thrive at Forever Wild

- Families that are looking for COMMUNITY!
- Families that are looking to raise their children in a village where all members of the village can give advice, redirection, support to all children
- Families who have children excited about learning new things
- Families that have children that can self-regulate emotions and behavior in a group
- Families that have children that can remain engaged in a group setting
- Families that feel it is important to have boundaries for their children's behavior and that promote their children's pro-social behavior in a group setting
- Families that understand the Forever Wild instruction at our activity center is adult and teacher led and modeled for children to have ample opportunity to practice new skills with the mentorship of adults
- Families that expect their children to follow the directions of an adult leader. For example, when an adult asks the children to come join in the circle, your family desires for your child to join the activity. Another example would be if an adult asks your child to stop running with scissors that your family would support that your child stops running.
- Families that promote positive language and positive behavior

It is best for members to be completely transparent about their family and children before joining our community. We find that for all community members to thrive, we need all families on board with the above. If it doesn't feel like a good fit for your family at this time, we are also happy to make recommendations for other programs that would work for your family.

What Do Fees Include?

The Community Access Fee includes access to all community events, WhatsApp groups, community check in meetings, and any meetups.

The Morning Drop Off Program Fees provide access to the morning session. Parents can drop their children off for this allotted time slot Monday – Friday. This fee is paid per child.

The Afternoon Drop Off Program Fees provide access to the afternoon session. Parents can drop their children off for this allotted time slot Monday – Friday. This fee is paid per child.

Refund Policy and Future Credits

Sometimes travel plans change or emergencies arise and families that have a membership might no longer be able to join us. Due to the nature of the program, travel planning and all families involved, all program fees are nonrefundable. In the event your family is unable to attend a session due to an emergency, you can use the amount you paid for that session as a credit for another one of our programs in the same year.
